Meeting Minutes
August 10, 2021

The Paris City Commission met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. viewable on Facebook live at www.facebook.com/cityofparisky on Tuesday, August 10, 2021.

Mayor, John Plummer called the meeting to order, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

City Clerk Stephanie Settles conducted roll call.

Present: Mayor, John Plummer; Commissioner, Wallis Brooks; Commissioner, Holli Gibson (arrived 9:03 a.m.); Commissioner, Stan Galbraith; Commissioner, Angela Roberts.

Others in Attendance: Interim City Manager, Mike Withrow; City Attorney, Bryan Beauman, and City Clerk, Stephanie Settles.

Upon determining a quorum was present for the transaction of business, Assistant City Manager Mike Withrow proceeded to conduct the meeting.

Approval of Minutes

Motion by Brooks, seconded by Plummer, to approve the regular meeting minutes of the July 13, 2021, meeting. Motion carried by roll call vote of 5-0 with Plummer, Brooks, Roberts, Galbraith, and Gibson voting Aye.

Special Request

Motion by Plummer, seconded by Brooks, approving the street closure of Main Street between Pleasant and 4th Streets and Ardery Place and Bankers Row Street at High Street from 5:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. for the AccuTran Industries 2021 Pumpkin Festival on September 18, 2021. Motion carried by roll call vote of 5-0 with Plummer, Brooks, Roberts, Galbraith, and Gibson voting Aye.

Motion by Gibson, seconded by Roberts, approving the closure of the 8th Street Eiffel Tower parking lot for a Golden Oldies Festival on August 27, 2021, from 4:30-10:30 p.m.

Motion by Brooks, seconded by Galbraith, approving Austin Render to work with the Paris Police department to arrange traffic control for a 3-day bicycle tour "Bourbon-Burn" and bourbon festival coming thru Paris on September 24-26, 2021. Motion carried by roll call vote of 5-0 with Plummer, Brooks, Roberts, Galbraith, and Gibson voting Aye.

Motion by Brooks, seconded by Roberts, approving half of the 5th Street parking lot on August 25th, 2021, for Fancy Flamingos one year in business celebration. Motion carried by roll call vote of 5-0 with Plummer, Brooks, Roberts, Galbraith, and Gibson voting Aye.

Curbside Solid Waste and Recycling

Francis Ritchie with Rumpke Waste and Recycling spoke in relation to contract renewal. Concerns were expressed with trash receptacles being left in the middle of driveways, cans half emptied, and random trash left lying around cans on the ground. Ms. Ritchie stated issues cannot be addressed if they are not aware, and to please report them. Renewal options will be drafted for a future review.

Old Business

Commissioner Gibson discussed several options for recruiting firms for the vacant City Manager position, stating she is waiting on a couple proposals. No action was taken.

Motion by Gibson, seconded by Roberts, approving a resolution that the City of Paris will be a participant with the Bourbon County Fiscal Court on the New Parks and Recreational complex and will explore potential funding avenues.

First reading of an ordinance relating to city streets and sidewalks was read by Bryan Beauman. No action was taken.

First reading of an ordinance relating to Peddlers and Solicitors was read by Bryan Beauman. No action was taken.

Motion by Plummer, seconded by Brooks, approving Epp-Lectric Inc. to replace approximately 24 utility poles along the grassy strip on the west side of main street between the curb and sidewalk paralleling South Main St from 14th Street to 20th Street at a cost of \$ 14,470.40 per 40-hour week for approximately four weeks. Motion carried by roll call vote of 5-0 with Plummer, Brooks, Roberts, Galbraith, Gibson voting Aye.

ORDER 2021-20**

AN ORDER APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL ADMINISTRATORS FOR ENFORCEMENT OF STATE AND CITY LAW, ORDINANCE AND REGULATIONS.

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF PARIS, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section I: That Myron Thomas, Earl Hatter, Larry Barrett, Joe Stevenson, Adam Harmon, OC Jones, and William Bell of the Paris Police Department are hereby appointed as agents of Alcohol Beverage Control Enforcement Authority.

Section II: That duties of such deputies shall be as determined by the City ABC Administrator but shall primarily consist of enforcement of state and city laws, ordinances, and regulations in the area of Alcoholic Beverage Control.
