Key Accountabilities:

Employee is responsible for but not limited to the following.

- Basic knowledge or the ability to learn water distribution and waste water collections systems.
- Knowledge of the tools and equipment used to maintain the lines throughout the city.
- Knowledge of the tools and equipment used and preventative maintenance practices.
- Ability to understand and to follow instructions. All other related duties as assigned.

Special Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

- The familiarity with or ability to learn principles and practices applied in the operation and maintenance of water systems.
- Ability to inspect utility lines and to detect flaws and defects.
- Ability to quantify amounts registered on meters and charts accurately and maintain records of operations.
- Ability to understand and follow instructions.
- Ability to operate equipment and machinery safely and efficiently.
